The Need for Different

- New Mexico consistently ranks at or very near the bottom nationally for student achievement and child well-being.
- Students that cannot read proficiently by the end of 3rd grade are 4 times as likely to drop out of school. For students that come from minority & low-income backgrounds, they are 8 times as likely to drop out of school.



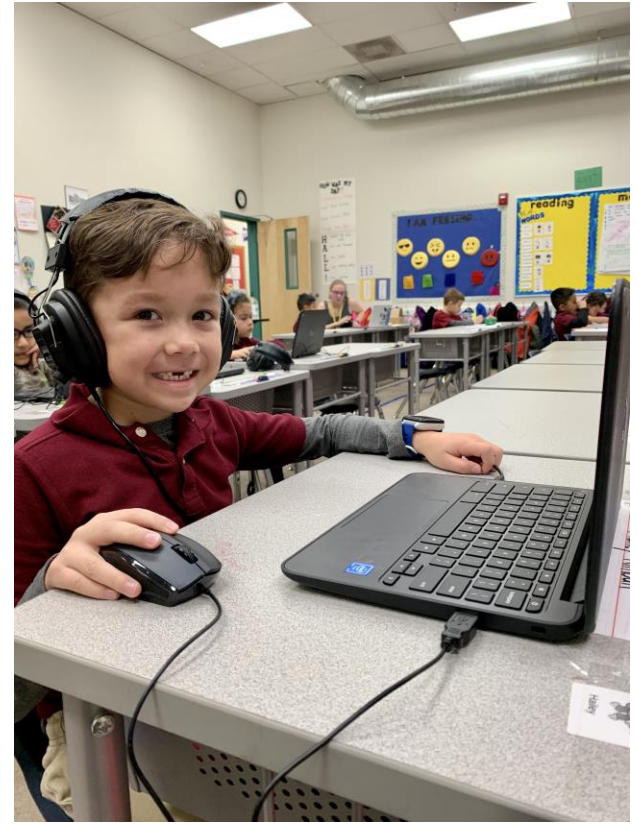
