




QPR Training

QPR stands for Question, Persuade, and Refer – the 3 simple steps anyone can learn to help save a life from suicide.



Just as people trained in CPR and the Heimlich Maneuver help save thousands of lives each year, people trained in QPR learn how to recognize the warning signs of a suicide crisis and how to question, persuade, and refer someone to help. Each year thousands of Americans, like you, are saying "Yes" to saving the life of a friend, colleague, sibling, or neighbor.



QPR can be learned in our Gatekeeper course in as little as one hour.

What is a Gatekeeper ?

- Gatekeepers can be anyone, but include parents, friends, neighbors, teachers, ministers, doctors, nurses, office supervisors, squad leaders, foremen, police officers, advisors, caseworkers, firefighters, and many others who are strategically positioned to recognize and refer someone at risk of suicide.

As a QPR-trained Gatekeeper you will learn to:

Recognize the warning signs of suicide

Know how to offer hope

Know how to get help and save a life

Boys & Girls Clubs across Wyoming and Montana are doing these trainings and 11 lives have been saved in just the Central WY Clubs alone


I have had numerous people reach out for help for loved ones and have helped them seek help
