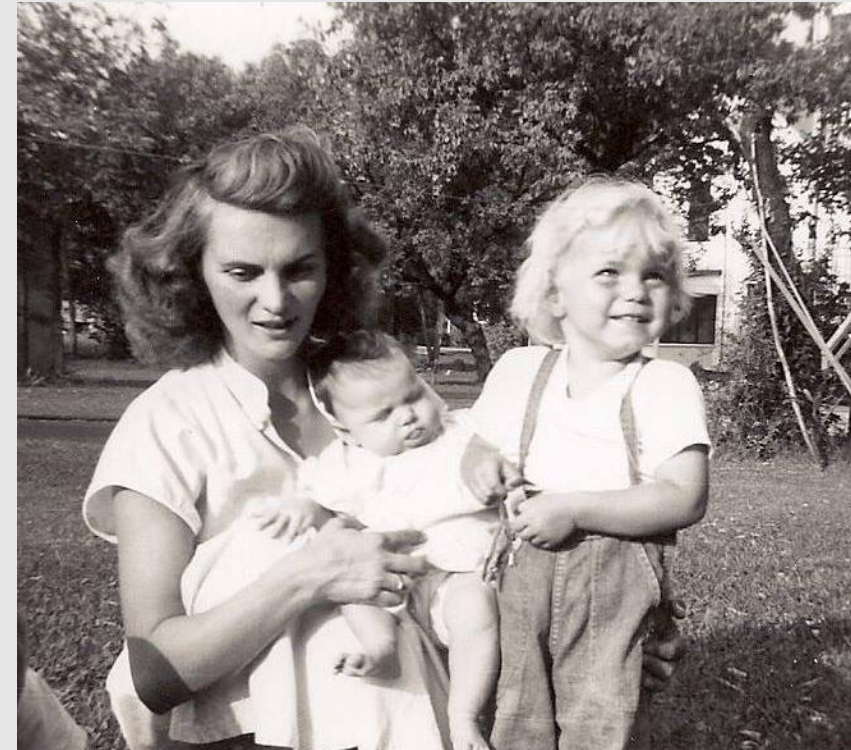

WYOMING HUNGER INITIATIVE REGIONAL DIRECTORS

Regional directors have been assigned multiple surrounding counties to bring a network together that can share ideas and voice concerns that may be solved on a regional level or be elevated to the Wyoming Hunger Initiative for statewide coordination. They work to create a platform for communication where food insecurity can be solved as a state, together.

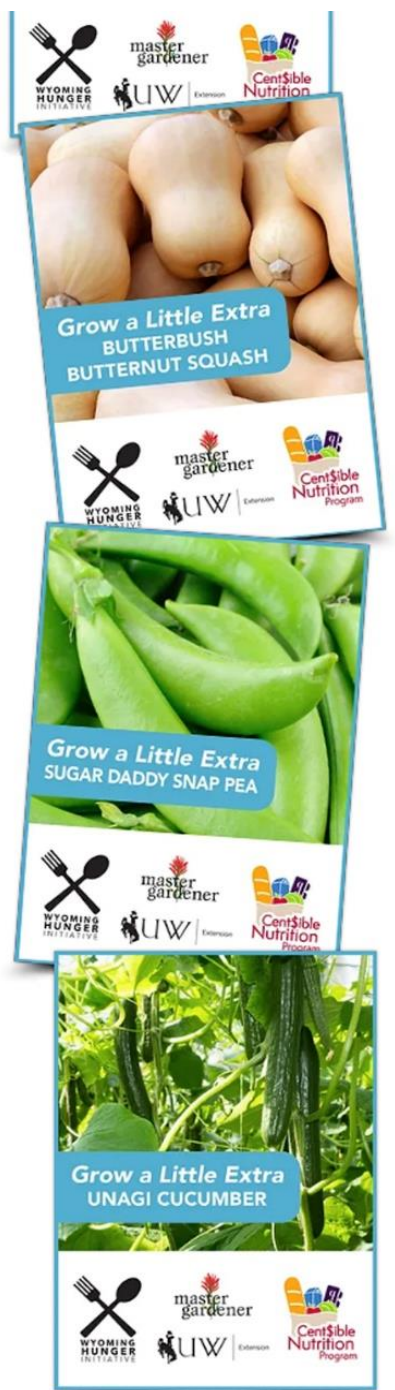

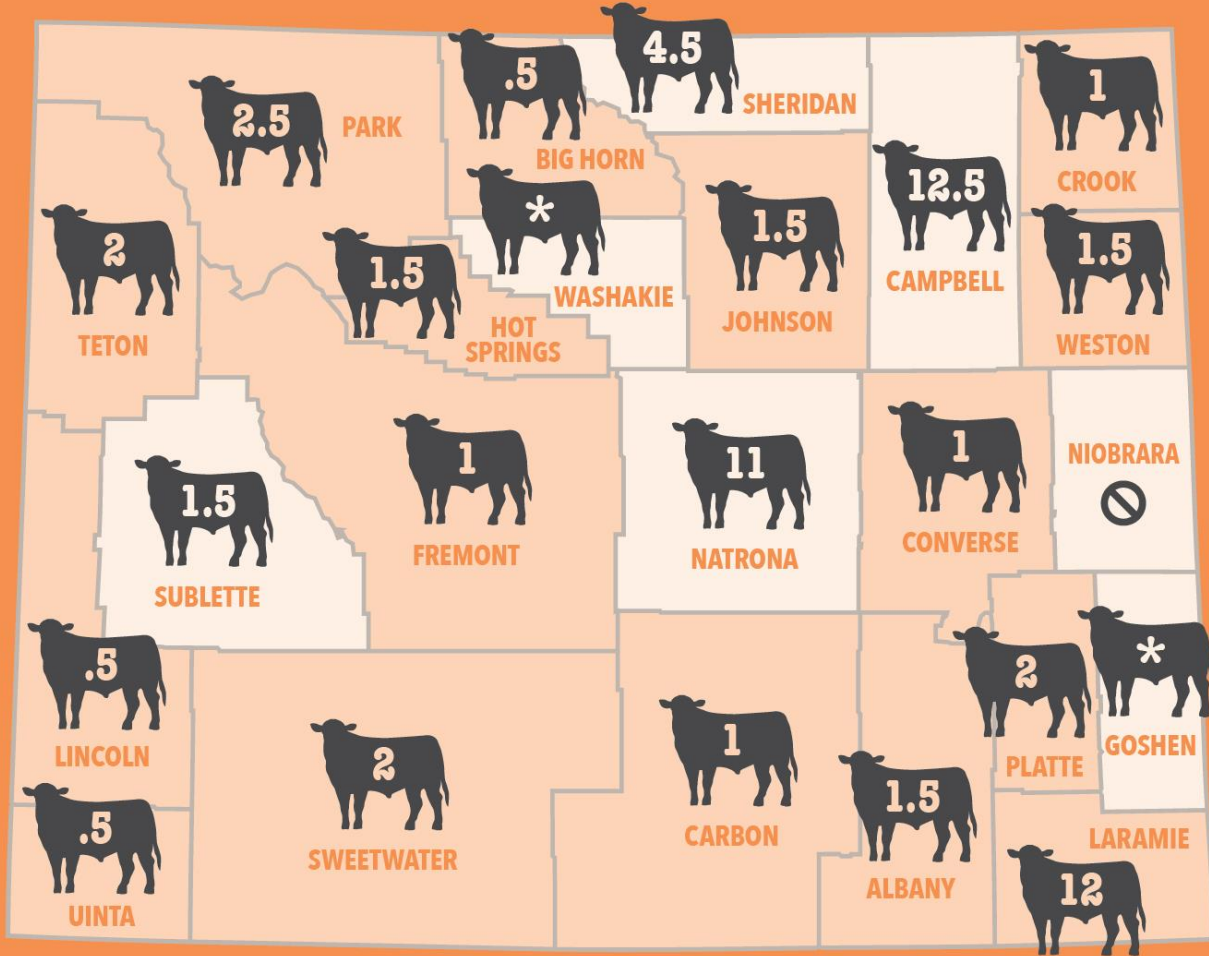




Beef for Backpacks

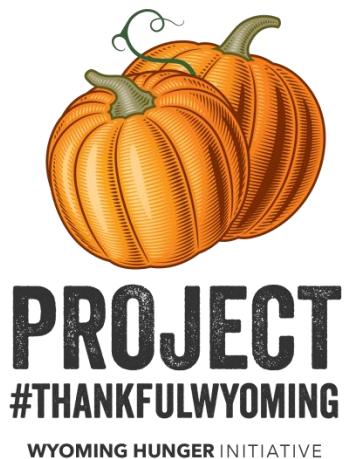
